4 Ground A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING CONSUMER  
5 TRANSACTION CONTRACTS THAT INCLUDE FINE PRINT THAT MODIFIES  
6 ANY SUBSTANTIVE PROVISION OF THE CONTRACT TO ALSO INCLUDE  
7 NOTICE OF THOSE MODIFICATIONS PRINTED IN BOLDFACE TYPE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
10 Section 1. Definition. As used in [section 2],  
11 "consumer transaction contract" means a sale, lease,  
12 assignment, award by chance, or other disposition of an item  
13 of goods, or a service to an individual for purposes that  
14 are primarily personal, family, or household.  
15 Section 2. Notice requirement. All consumer  
16 transaction contracts containing provisions in print smaller  
17 than the substantive portions of the contract that modify  
18 the substantive portions of the contract shall contain  
19 notice of that modification in boldface type.  
20 Section 3. Remedy. Any provision described by [section  
21 2] in a contract where the required notice is not included  
22 is void.
