(b) The county commissioners of each county shall, within 30 days after the election or appointment to fill a vacancy for any cause of any county attorney, certify such election or appointment to the state auditor, who shall thereafter draw warrants for such salary in the same manner as for state officers. In case of a vacancy, the county commissioners shall immediately notify the state auditor, and the auditor shall compute the salary due on the basis of said notification.
