A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 7-3-4462, MCA, TO INSURE THAT A CITY JUDGE NEED NOT BE AN ATTORNEY LICENSED TO PRACTICE IN MONTANA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-3-4462: MCA: is amended to read:

"7-3-4462. Office of city judge. (1) In each
municipality having a commission-manager form of government.

a city judge shall be elected every 4 years in a nonpartisan
election held in conjunction with the regularly scheduled
municipal election. The city judge shall hold office for a
term of 4 years.

- judge shall be set by ordinance by the commission. The ordinance shall be consistent with any rules adopted by the Montana supreme court on city judge qualifications and may not include the requirement that the city judge be licensed to practice law in the state of Hontana.
- (3) If a vacancy occurs in the office of city judge.

 the commission shall appoint a qualified individual to serve
 for the remainder of the term.
