A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING FOR FOUNDATION PROGRAM PAYMENT ELIGIBILITY TO SCHOOLS CLOSED DUE

TO EMERGENCIES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Emergency resulting from acts of God —
foundation program payment eligibility. (1) The existence of
a state of emergency may be proclaimed by the governor when
he finds that an act of God has occurred and that the safety
and welfare of the inhabitants of the state, or a portion of
the inhabitants, require the closing of schools or a
particular school.

- (2) The emergency shall terminate when the governor issues a proclamation to that effect.
- 18 (3) When a district board of trustees closes a school located within the boundaries of the territory included in the governor's proclamation of a state of emergency, the district trustees may include actual days lost, not to exceed 5 days, in their calculation of foundation program payment eligibility.
- 24 (4) A school district in which a school is closed for 25 more than 5 days in a school year pursuant to subsection (1)

- shall receive 2 days" credit for foundation program payment
- 2 purposes for each day school is held to make up for lost
- 3 days.
