BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-7-2203. NCA, is amended to read: #7-7-2203. Limitation on amount of bonded indebtedness. (1) Except as provided in subsections (?) and (3), no county shall issue bonds for any purpose which, with all outstanding bonds and warrants except county high school bonds and emergency bonds, will exceed 2 1/2% of the value of the taxable property therein, to be ascertained by the last assessment for state and county taxes previous to the issuance of such bonds.

(2) A county may issue bonds which, with all outstanding bonds and warrants, will exceed 2 1/2% but will not exceed 5 29% of the value of such taxable property, when necessary to do so, for the purpose of acquiring land for a site for county high school buildings and for erecting or acquiring buildings thereon and furnishing and equipping the

same for county high school purposes.
