(1) Any 11 person who is the holder of a valid resident elk license or 12 13 a Class B-10 nonresident big game combination license may apply for a special elk license upon payment of a-fee-of-of 14 the processing fee established by [section 2]. 15 (2) Any person who is the holder of a valid resident 16 deer license or any nonresident who holds a Class B-2 17 license and a valid deer tag may apply for a special deer 18 license upon payment of --fee-of--\$1 the processing fee 19 20 established by [section 2]. 21 (3) The department shall have the authority to 22 promulgate such rules and regulations as are necessary to

 25 The department may collect a nonrefundable processing fee of

1 52 for each species for each resident or nonresident 2 application for drawing elk or deer hunting licenses or 3 permits. This fee shall be deposited in the fish and game 4 earmarked revenue fund. A successful applicant in a drawing 5 for an elk or deer hunting license or permit shall receive 6 the license or permit and is not required to make further 7 payment.

(2) The department may collect a nonrefundable 8 9 processing fee of \$2 for each species for each resident or nonresident application for drawing mooses sneeps or goat 10 11 hunting licenses or vermits. This fee shall be deposited in the fish and game carserked revenue accounts Whenever an 12 applicant is successful in a drawing for a moose, sheep, or 13 14 opat hunting license or permits the department shall bill 15 the individual for the cost of the license or permit. Upon payment of the correct fee, the department shall issue the 16 17 license or permit.

(3) Applicants for antelope hunting license drawings
shall forward the full purchase price for an antelope
license with the application for the drawing. Unsuccessful
applicants in the antelope hunting license drawing will have
the purchase price refunded.

23 (4) The payment of processing Rees or the full price
24 of a license or permit prior to a drawing confers no hunting

A successful applicant in a drawing for an elk or deer hunting license or permit shall receive the license or permit and is not required to make further payment.

(2) The department may collect a nonrefundable 8 processing fee of \$2 for each species for each resident or 9 10 nonresident application for drawing mooses sheep, or goat hunting licenses or permits. This fee shall be deposited in 11 12 the fish and game earmarked revenue account. Whenever an 13 applicant is successful in a drawing for a moose, sheep, or 14 goat hunting license or permit, the department shall bill 15 the Individual for the cost of the license or permit. Upon payment of the correct fee, the department shall issue the 16 license or permit. 17

(3) Applicants for antelope hunting license drawings
shall forward the full purchase price for an antelope
license with the application for the drawing. Unsuccessful
applicants in the antelope hunting license drawing will have
the purchase price refunded.

(4) The payment of processing fees or the full price
of a license or permit prior to a drawing confers no hunting
rights or privileges.
