A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE APPROVAL BY
A MAJORITY OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS VOTING BEFORE A
MUNICIPALITY WITH A POPULATION OF 10,000 OR MORE MAY
CONTRACT WITH A PRIVATE VENDOR FOR CERTAIN SERVICES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Vote required to contract for certain services.

- (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a municipality with a population of 10,000 or more may contract with a private vendor to provide water, sewer, garbage collection, parking, or fire protection services only if the contract is voted upon and approved by a majority of the qualified electors of the municipality voting on the question.
- (2) (a) If a municipality with a population of 10,000 or more is providing a service listed in subsection (1) by means of a contract with a private vendor on [the effective date of this act], the municipality may continue to provide that service by means of contracting with private vendors without submitting any future contracts to voter approval as required by subsection (1). This exemption includes new or

renewal contracts for the same service with the same vendor
or different vendors. The exemption is lost if the
municipality ceases to provide the service by means of a
private vendor.

5 (b) In an emergency situation, a municipality with a
6 population of 10,000 or more may enter a contract with a
7 private vendor to provide any service listed in subsection
8 (1). The contract may only cover the period of time during
9 which the emergency exists.

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
