 12 three classes of licenses issued under the provisions of
 13 this chapter, and such classes of licenses are hereby
 14 designated as Classes A, B, and C. Any applicant for a
 15 license under the provisions hereof shall specify in his
 16 application the class of license applied for.

17 (2) The holder of a Class A license shall be entitled
 18 to engage in the public contracting business within the
 19 state without any limitation as to the value of a single
 20 public contract project; subject, however, to such
 21 prequalification requirements as may be imposed by the
 22 public body or bodies referred to in 15-50-101(1)(a). At the
 23 time of making the application for such license, the
 24 applicant shall pay to the registrar a fee in the sum of
 25 ~~\$200~~ \$300.

1 (3) The holder of a Class B license shall be entitled
 2 to engage in the public contracting business within the
 3 state but shall not be entitled to engage in the
 4 construction of any single public contract project of a
 5 value in excess of ~~\$50,000~~ \$100,000 and shall pay to the
 6 registrar as a license fee the sum of ~~\$100~~ \$150 for such
 7 Class B license at the time of making application therefor.

8 (4) The holder of a Class C license shall be entitled
 9 to engage in the public contracting business within the
 10 state but shall not be entitled to engage in the
 11 construction of any single public contract project of a
 12 value in excess of ~~\$25,000~~ \$50,000 and shall pay to the
 13 registrar as a license fee the sum of ~~\$10~~ \$50 at the time of
 14 making application therefor."

(2) The holder of a Class A license shall be entitled
to engage in the public contracting business within the
state without any limitation as to the value of a single
public contract project; subject, however, to such

time of making the application for such license, the
applicant shall pay to the registrar a fee in the sum of

construction of any single public contract project of a
value in excess of ~~\$50,000~~ \$100,000 and shall pay to the
registrar as a license fee the sum of ~~\$100~~ \$150 \$100 for
such Class B license at the time of making application
therefor.

(4) The holder of a Class C license shall be entitled
to engage in the public contracting business within the
state but shall not be entitled to engage in the
construction of any single public contract project of a
value in excess of ~~\$25,000~~ \$50,000 and shall pay to the
registrar as a license fee the sum of ~~\$10~~ \$50 at the time of
making application therefor.

(5) THE HOLDER OF A CLASS D LICENSE IS ENTITLED TO
ENGAGE IN THE PUBLIC CONTRACTING BUSINESS WITHIN THE STATE
BUT MAY NOT ENGAGE IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF ANY SINGLE PUBLIC
CONTRACT PROJECT OF A VALUE IN EXCESS OF \$15,000 AND SHALL
PAY TO THE REGISTRAR AS A LICENSE FEE THE SUM OF \$15 AT THE
TIME OF MAKING APPLICATION THEREFOR."

registrar as a license fee the sum of ~~\$100~~ ~~\$150~~ \$100 for
such Class B license at the time of making application
therefor.

(4) The holder of a Class C license shall be entitled
to engage in the public contracting business within the
state but shall not be entitled to engage in the
construction of any single public contract project of a
value in excess of ~~\$25,000~~ \$50,000 and shall pay to the
registrar as a license fee the sum of ~~\$10~~ \$50 at the time of
making application therefor.

(5) THE HOLDER OF A CLASS D LICENSE IS ENTITLED TO
ENGAGE IN THE PUBLIC CONTRACTING BUSINESS WITHIN THE STATE
BUT MAY NOT ENGAGE IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF ANY SINGLE PUBLIC
CONTRACT PROJECT OF A VALUE IN EXCESS OF \$15,000 AND SHALL
PAY TO THE REGISTRAR AS A LICENSE FEE THE SUM OF \$15 AT THE
TIME OF MAKING APPLICATION THEREFOR."
