5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT EXEMPTING AGRICULTURAL  
6 EMPLOYERS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF 39-2-305, MCA."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

8 Section 1. Section 39-2-305, MCA, is amended to read:

9 "39-2-305. Employment of aliens not lawfully  
10 authorized to accept employment prohibited. (1) No  
11 nonagricultural employer may knowingly employ an alien who  
12 is not lawfully authorized to accept employment.

13 (2) A person convicted of violating this section shall  
14 be fined no more than \$300.

15 (3) The department of labor and industry or a person  
16 harmed by a violation of this section may sue to enjoin an  
17 employer from violating this section and to gain other  
18 appropriate relief."
