A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE  
TRANSPORT OF ANTLERS IN VELVET; PROVIDING A PENALTY AND  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Transport of antlers in velvet. (1) No  
person may transport antlers in velvet.

(2) A person who violates this section for the first  
time is punishable by a fine of not less than \$500 or more  
than \$1,500. For each additional violation, a person is  
punishable by a fine of not less than \$500 or more than  
\$1,500 and by imprisonment in the county jail for a period  
of not more than 30 days.

Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on  
passage and approval.
