*39-51-1103. Contributions by employers required --student status exception -- payments in lieu thereof
authorized for certain employers. (1) Contributions shall
accrue and become payable by each employer for each calendar
year in which he is subject to this chapter with respect to
wages, as defined in 39-51-201(19), paid for employment, as
defined in this chapter, occurring during such calendar
year.

- (2) Such contributions shall become due and be paid by each employer to the division for the fund in accordance with such regulations as the division may prescribe and shall not be deducted in whole or in part from the wages of individuals in his employ.
- (3) In the payment of any contributions, a fractionalpart of a cent shall be disregarded unless it amounts to

- one-half cent or more. In which case it shall be increased to 1 cent.
- 3 (4) (a) Nonprofit organizations defined in section 4 501(c)(3) of the federal Internal Revenue Code and which are 5 exempt from tax under section 501(a) of such code may elect 6 to make payments in lieu of contributions.
- 7 (b) A group of nonprofit organizations may elect, with 8 the approval of the division, to act as a group in 9 fulfilling the requirements of 39-51-1106(1) or of this 10 chapter.
- 11 (5) The state and its political subdivisions.
