 5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ALL
 6 RECORDS REGARDING THE CONSUMER COUNSEL FEE BE FURNISHED TO
 7 THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION
 8 AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATION."

 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Furnishing of records to the department of
 12 revenue. To facilitate the administration of the consumer
 13 counsel fee provided for in 69-1-223 and 69-1-224 by the
 14 department of revenue, the public service commission and the
 15 department of public service regulation shall furnish the
 16 department of revenue with copies of any record relating to
 17 the regulated companies which the department of revenue
 18 requests.

19 Section 2. Codification. It is intended that section 1
 20 of this act be codified as an integral part of Title 69,
 21 chapter 1, part 2, and the provisions of Title 69, chapter
 22 1, apply to section 1.


