6 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION  
7 53-6-105, MCA, TO PROHIBIT DISCRIMINATION AGAINST APPLICANTS  
8 FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
11 Section 1. Section 53-6-105, MCA, is amended to read:  
12 "53-6-105. Discrimination prohibited. No  
13 discrimination shall be practiced or asserted against. It is  
14 unlawful for a provider of services under this chapter to  
15 discriminate against, delay, or deny furnishing care or  
16 services to any applicant for or recipient of care and  
17 services under this part chapter on the basis of race,  
18 color, or religion, creed, political ideas, sex, ages,  
19 marital status, physical or mental handicap, national  
20 origin, and the furnishing of care and services under this  
21 part to any applicant or recipient thereof shall not be  
22 delayed or denied on the basis of race, color, or national  
23 origin or on the basis that the applicant is a recipient of  
24 federal, state, or local public assistance."
