HOUSE BILL NO. 210 INTRODUCED BY Holenes 1 2 3 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO INCREASE THE TAX ON 4 CIGARETTES SOLD OR POSSESSED IN THE STATE OF MONTANA BY 1 5 CENT & PACK AND TO AUTHORIZE USE OF THE FUNDS FROM THIS 6 INCREASE TO FUND A TUMOR REGISTRY AND A TELEPHONE CONSUMER 7 HEALTH EDUCATION PROJECT: AND AMENDING SECTION 16-11-111, 8 HCA.* 9

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 16-11-111, MCA, is amended to read: 12 #16-11-111. Cigarette sales tax. (1) From and after 13 March 5, 1971, there is hereby levied, imposed, and assessed 14 15 and there shall be collected and paid to the state of Montana upon cigarettes sold or possessed in this state the 16 following excise tax which shall be paid prior to the time 17 of sale and delivery thereof: 9 cents on each package 18 containing not more than 20 cigarettes and, when packages 19 contain more than 20 cigarettes, then 9 cents on each 20 or 20 fraction of 20 cigarettes contained in such package. 21

22 (2) From and after December 6: 1950; there is hereby 23 levied, imposed, and assessed and there shall be collected 24 and paid to the state of Montana upon cigarettes sold or 25 possessed in this state the following excise tax, in LC 0461/01

addition to the excise tax on cigarettes levied, imposed, 1 2 and assessed by subsection (1) of this section, an additional tax which shall be paid prior to the time of sale 3 and delivery of such cigarettes: 2 cents on each package 4 5 containing not more than 20 cigarettes and, when packages 6 contain more than 20 cigarettes, then 2 cents on each 20 or 7 fraction of 20 cigarettes contained in such package; which 8 additional tax shall continue in force until the payment and 9 retirement of all bonds of the state of Montana, and the 10 payment of interest thereon, issued under the authority of 11 Initiative No. 54, as amended, for the purpose of paying an 12 honorarium to the residents of Montana who were in military 13 service in the military forces of the United States in World 14 War II, the Korean conflict, or World War I and until the 15 payment and retirement of all long-range building program 16 bonds issued under the provisions of Title 17, chapter 5.

17 (3) From and after July 1, 1963, there is hereby 18 levied. imposed. and assessed and there shall be collected 19 and paid to the state of Montana upon cigarettes sold or 20 possessed in this state the following excise tax: in 21 addition to the excise tax on cijarettes levied, imposed, z, and assessed by subsections (1) and (?) of this section, an additional tax which shall be paid prior to the time of sale 23 24 and delivery of such cigarettes: 1 cent on each package containing not more than 20 cigarettes and, when packages 25

1 contain more than 20 cigarettes, then 1 cent on each 20 or 2 fraction of 20 cigarettes contained in such package; which additional tax shall continue in force until the payment and 3 retirement of the additional bonds of the state of Montana 4 5 authorized by amendatory acts of the 35th and 38th legislative assemblies and the payment of the interest 6 7 thereon and until the payment and retirement of all long-range building program bonds issued under the 8 provisions of Title 17, chapter 5. 9 10 [4] From and after July 1. 1979. there is hereby

11 levied, imposed, and assessed and there shall be collected 12 and paid to the state of Nontana upon cigarettes sold or 13 possessed in this state the following excise taxa in addition to the excise tax on cigarettes levied, imposed. 14 and assessed by subsections (1) through (3) of this section. 15 an additional tax which shall be paid prior to the time of 16 17 sale and delivery of such cigarettes: 1 cent on each package 18 containing not more than 20 cigarettes and when packages 19 contain more than 20 cigarettes, then 1 cent on each 20 or fraction of 20 cigarettes contained in such package: which 20 21 additional tax shall be used to fund a statewide cancer 22 tumor registry and a telephone consumer health education project. These programs shall be administered by the 23 department of health and environmental sciences. The 24 25 department of health and environmental sciences is

- 2 sciences as provided in Title 18: MCA.*
