10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11       Section 1. Section 20-1-204, MCA, is amended to read:  
12       "20-1-204. County attorney's duties. Upon request of  
13       the county superintendent or the trustees of any school  
14       district or community college district, the county attorney  
15       shall be their legal adviser and shall prosecute and defend  
16       all suits to which such persons, in their capacity as public  
17       officials, may be a party; however, the trustees of any  
18       school district or community college district may, upon  
19       consent--of--the--county--attorneys in their discretion, employ  
20       any other attorney licensed in Montana to perform any legal  
21       services in connection with school or community college  
22       board business."
