A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION TO ESTABLISH A PROGRAM FOR THE REMOVAL OF SILT FROM RESERVOIRS BEHIND DAMS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Silt-removal program. (1) The department of natural resources and conservation shall develop and implement a program for the removal of silt from reservoirs behind dams subject to department jurisdiction under 85-15-103 and 85-15-104. This program shall formulate criteria to determine the economic and technical feasibility of silt removal. Where feasible, excess electric power from power-generating dams shall be utilized for the removal of silt from the reservoirs behind these dams. The department shall develop methods for silt removal and shall provide technical assistance to private persons and governmental agencies in establishing programs for particular dams. The department may charge for this assistance and may enter contracts for providing services related to silt removal.

(2) The silt-removal program may be extended to dams and reservoirs owned or operated by the United States upon

agreement of the federal government.
