5 kilogram, or multiples of 1/2 kilogram, within reasonable
6 variations or tolerances that shall be adopted by rules of
7 the department. This section does not apply to biscuits,
8 buns, or rolls weighing 8 ounces or 1/4 kilogram or less or
9 to "stale bread" sold and expressly represented at the time
0 of sale as such."
