A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE SLURRY TRANSPORT OF COAL IS NOT A BENEFICIAL USE OF WATER; AMENDING SECTION 85-2-102. MCA."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 85-2-102, MCA, is amended to read:
#85-2-102. Definitions. Unless the context requires
otherwise, in this chapter the following definitions apply:

- (1) "Appropriate" means to divert, impound, or withdraw (including by stock for stock water) a quantity of water or, in the case of a public agency, to reserve water in accordance with 85-2-316.
- (2) "Beneficial use", unless otherwise provided: means a use of water for the benefit of the appropriator, other persons, or the public, including but not limited to agricultural (including stock water), domestic, fish and wildlife, industrial, irrigation, mining, municipal, power, and recreational uses. A use-of-water-for-slurry-to-export coal-from-Montana-is-not-s-beneficial-uses-Slurry-is-s mixture-of-water-and-insoluble-matters
- (3) "Board" means the board of natural resources and conservation provided for in 2-15-3302.

  2 issued by the department under 85-2-210, subsections (1) and
  3 (2) of 85-2-306, and 85-2-315.
  - (5) "Declaration" means the declaration of an existing right filed with the department under 85-2-203.
- 6 (6) "Department" means the department of natural
  7 resources and conservation provided for in Title 2, chapter
  8 15, part 33.
  - (7) "Existing right" means a right to the use of water which would be protected under the law as it existed prior to July 1, 1973.
  - (8) "Groundwater" means any water beneath the land surface or beneath the bed of a stream, lake, reservoir, or other body of surface water, and which is not a part of that surface water.
  - (9) "Permit" scans the permit to appropriate issued by the department under 85-2-301 through 85-2-303 and 85-2-306 through 85-2-314.

- 5 ##2+(13) "Waste" means the unreasonable loss of water 6 through the design or negligent operation of an 7 appropriation or water distribution facility or the 8 application of water to anything but a beneficial use.
- 9 #131(14) "Water" means all water of the state, surface and subsurface: regardless of its character or manner of 10 11 occurrence, including geothermal water and diffuse surface 12 water.
- 1141(15) "Well" means any artificial opening or 13 excavation in the ground, however made, by which groundwater 14 is sought or can be obtained or through which it flows under 15 natural pressures or is artificially withdrawn." 16
- NEW SECTION. Section 2. Slurry transport of coal. 17 (1) Because of the shortage of economically available water 18 19 in the coal-mining regions of Montana and the availability of alternative, economical means of transportation, the use 20 of water for the slurry transport of coal is detrimental to 21 the conservation and protection of the water resources of 22 23 the state.
- (2) The use of water for the slurry transport of coal 24 is not a beneficial use of water. 25
