 5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION
 6 69-12-504, MCA, TO REVISE AND CLARIFY THE PROCEDURE FOR
 7 REQUESTING RATE REVISIONS BY MOTOR CARRIERS."

 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 10 Section 1. Section 69-12-504, MCA, is amended to read:
 11 "69-12-504. Procedure to revise rate schedule. (1) No
 12 motor carrier shall change or revise any rate, fare, charge,
 13 classification, or rule of service contained in its schedule
 14 without first obtaining approval therefor from the
 15 commission. Such changes or revisions shall be made by
 16 filing with the commission the tariff sheet or sheets
 17 containing such changes or revisions, plainly stating the
 18 changes or revisions to be made, and by submitting at the
 19 same time testimony and exhibits supporting the requested
 20 change or revision and prepared by the motor carrier.
 21 Additional testimony or exhibits may be submitted before or
 22 during the hearing provided for in 69-12-505 and may be
 23 submitted after the hearing with the approval of the
 24 commission. The public shall be provided with such notice of
 25 the proposed changes or revisions as the commission shall,

1 by rule, require.
 2 (2) The tariff sheets containing such changes or
 3 revisions shall be ~~deemed approved and effective 30 days~~
 4 ~~after the same are filed unless the proposed revisions or~~
 5 ~~changes are suspended or disallowed by the commission prior~~
 6 ~~to the expiration of the 30-day period~~ filed with the
 7 commission at least 45 days before the proposed effective
 8 date. The change or revision shall be effective on the
 9 stated effective date unless disallowed or suspended by the
 10 commission prior to this date. However, the commission
 11 may, for good cause, allow any change or revision to become
 12 effective in on less than 30 days after the filing thereof
 13 45 days' notice."
