24 25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-4-203, MCA, is amended to read:

#20-4-203. Teacher tenure. [1] Whenever a teacher has been elected by the offer and acceptance of a contract for the fourth consecutive year of employment by a district in a position requiring teacher certification except as a district superintendent, the teacher shall be deemed to be reelected from year to year thereafter as a tenure teacher at the same salary and in the same or a comparable position of employment as that provided by the last executed contract with such teacher, unless:

fif(a) the trustees resolve by majority vote of their membership to terminate the services of the teacher in accordance with the provisions of 20-4-204; or

the teacher will attain the age of 65 years before the ensuing September 1 and the trustees have notified the teacher in writing by April 1 that his services

will not be needed in the ensuing school fiscal year, except
that the trustees may continue to employ such a teacher from
year to year until the school fiscal year following his 70th
birthday.
