Section 1. Section 50-35-103, MCA, is amended to read: \*50-35-103. Labeling requirement for foreign seat. On meat produced outside the United States of America, the store or supplier of fresh meat shall place the words "FOREIGN MEAT" or "MEAT FROM (country of origin)" in prominent letters upon the package in which such meat is sold to the consumer or store. If the country of origin of foreign meat is unknown, the words "COUNTRY OF GRIGIN UNKNOWN\* shall be placed upon the package in like manner.\* Section 2. Section 50-35-104.
