INTRODUCED BY Frank

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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL PERMIT TO SELL ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT A PICNIC. CONVENTION, FAIR, CIVIC OR COMMUNITY ENTERPRISE, OR SPORTING EVENT CONDUCTED BY AN ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION; AMENDING SECTIONS 16-4-301 AND 16-4-501. MCA.\*

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HONTANA:

Section 1. Section 16-4-301, MCA, is amended to read: #16-4-301. Special permits to sell all alcoholic beverages or beer -- application and issuance. (1) (a) Any association or corporation conducting a picnic, convention, fair, civic or community enterprise, or sporting event shall in the discretion of the liquor division be entitled to a special permit to sell beer or a special permit to sell all alcoholic beverages to the patrons of such event to be consumed within the enclosure wherein the event is held.

(b) The application of any such association or corporation shall be presented 10 days in advance and shall describe the location of such enclosure where such event is to be held, the nature of the event, and the period when it is contemplated that the event will be held. The application shall be accompanied by the amount of the permit fee-

- (2) (a) A post of a nationally chartered veterans\* organization or a lodge of a recognized national fraternal organization not otherwise licensed under this code shall, in the discretion of the department, without notice or hearing as provided in 16-4-207, be entitled to a special permit to sell beer or a special permit to sell all alcoholic beverages at such post or lodge to members and their quests only, to be consumed within the hall or building of such post or lodge.
- (b) The application of such nationally chartered veterans\* organization or lodge of a recognized national fraternal organization shall describe the location of the hall or building where the special permit will be used and the date it will be used.
- 21 (c) The special permit issued shall be for a 24-hour 22 period only ending at 2 a.m., and the department may not 23 issue more than 12 such permits to any such post or lodge 24 during a calendar year.\*

- (2) The permit fee under 16-4-301(1) is computed at 15 the rate of \$15 a day for eech-day-beer-is-sold-at-those 16 17 events-losting-2-or-more-days-but-in-no-case--be--less--than 430 the sale of beer only, with a minimum fee of \$30, and 16 \$30 a day for the sale of all alcoholic beverages, with a 19 20 miniaum fee of \$60.
- 21 (3) The permit fee under 16-4-301(2) is \$10 for the 22 sale of beer only or \$20 for the sale of all alcoholic 23 beverages.
- 24 (4) Passenger carrier licenses shall be issued upon payment by the applicant of an annual license fee in the sum 25

of \$300. 1

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- (5) The annual license fee for a license to sell wine 2 on the premises, when issued as an amendment to a beer-only license, is \$200.
- (6) The annual fee for resort retail liquor licenses 5 within a given resort area shall be \$2,000 for each license.
  - (7) Each licensee licensed under the quotas of 16-4-201 shall pay an annual license fee as follows:
  - (a) except as hereinafter provided, for each license outside of incorporated cities and incorporated towns or in incorporated cities and incorporated towns with a population of less than 2,000, \$400;
  - (b) except as hereinafter provided, for each license in incorporated cities with a population of more than 2,000 and less than 5,000 or within a distance of 5 miles thereof, measured in a straight line from the nearest entrance of the premises to be licensed to the nearest boundary of such city. \$500;
- (c) except as hereinafter provided, for each license in incorporated cities with a population of more than 5,000 and less than 10,000 or within a distance of 5 miles thereof, measured in a straight line from the nearest 22 entrance of the premises to be licensed to the nearest 23 boundary of such city, \$650;
  - (d) for each license in incorporated cities with a

population of 10,000 or more or within a distance of 5 miles thereof, measured in a straight line from the nearest entrance of the premises to be licensed to the nearest boundary of such city, \$800;

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- (e) the distance of 5 miles from the corporate limits of any incorporated cities and incorporated towns is measured in a straight line from the nearest entrance of the premises to be licensed to the nearest boundary of such city or town; and where the premises of the applicant to be licensed are situated within 5 miles of the corporate boundaries of two or more incorporated cities or incorporated towns of different populations, the license fee chargeable by the larger incorporated city or incorporated town applies and shall be paid by the applicant. When the premises of the applicant to be licensed are situated within an incorporated town or incorporated city and any portion of the incorporated town or incorporated city is without a 5-mile limit, the license fee chargeable by the smaller incorporated town or incorporated city applies and shall be paid by the applicant.
- (f) an applicant for the issuance of an original license to be located in areas described in subsection (d) of this subsection shall pay a one-time original license fee of \$20,000 for any such license issued. The one-time license fee of \$20,000 shall not apply to any transfer or renewal of

- a license duly issued prior to July 1, 1974. All licenses,
- however, are subject to the annual renewal fee of \$800.
- 3 (8) The license fees herein provided for are exclusive
- 4 of and in addition to other license fees chargeable in
- 5 Montana for the sale of alcoholic beverages.\*

#### DESCRIPTION

This bill allows issuance of a special permit to sell all alcoholic beverages at a picnic, convention, fair, civic or community enterprise, or sporting event conducted by an association or corporation.

#### ASSUMPTIONS

- 1) The permit fee for the sale of alcoholic beverages is \$30 a day with a minimum fee of \$60.
- 2) The average fee per request is \$67.50.
- 3) The number of requests for special permits will be 400 a year for FY80 and FY81.
- 4) Administrative costs will be absorbed.
