€ BILL NO. 286 1 BILL, FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: COMPOSITION OF AND THE METHOD OF SELECTING AND APPOINTING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF REAL ESTATE AND TO END THE TERMS OF CURRENT BOARD MEMBERS; AMENDING SECTION 2-15-1642. MCA; AND 8 PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE. 9 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 11 Section 1. Section 2-15-1642, MCA, is amended to read: "2-15-1642. Board of real estate. (1) There is a board 12 13 of real estate. (2) The board consists of five members. The members 14 are appointed by the governor. The members shall be: 15 16 (a) residents of this state. At-least-two Four members shall be active and licensed real estate brokers or salesmen 17 18 and have been actively engaged in the real estate business as a broker or salesman in this state for not less than 5 19 continuous years before appointment. Three of these members 20 21 sust be selected from a list of eligible persons submitted 22 by the realtors professional organization. One member shall 23 be a representative of the public who is not a state 24 government officer or employee and who is not engaged in 25 business as a real estate broker or salesman.

(b) appointed so not more than three members and not more than two board licensees are from the congressional district. If a member takes up residence in a district different from the one in which he resided at the time of appointment, he vacates his membership on the board. (c) appointed, in the event of a vacancy, by appointing a resident from the same district as the member whose office has been vacated. (3) Not more than three members, including the chairman, shall be from the same political party. (4) The members shall serve for a term of 4 years: commencing after [the effectiveAof this act]. (5) The members' appointments must be confirmed by the senate, according to the procedure established by 5-5-301 through 5-5-303. t5)161 The board is allocated to the department for administrative purposes only as prescribed in 2-15-121.
