9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 2-15-3616. MCA. is amended to read:
 "2-15-1616. Board of hearing aid dispensers. (1) There
 is a board of hearing aid dispensers.

13 (2) The board consists of five members appointed by
 14 the governor. The members are:

15 (a) one member appointed from a list submitted by the 16 Hontana academy of oto-ophthalmology. This member shall hold 17 or be eligible for a certificate of qualification from the 13 American board of otolaryngology.

(b) one member appointed from a list submitted by the
Hontana speech and hearing association. This member shall
hold or be eligible for a certificate of clinical competence
in audiology from the American speech and hearing
association.

24 (c) three two members appointed from a list submitted
 25 by the Montana hearing aid dealers' society. These members

shall have been qualified dispensers and fitters of hearing
 aids for at least 5 years before their appointment to the
 board.

4 <u>(d) one member to represent the public who is 60 years</u>
5 of age or older and who is not engaged in the practice of

6 dispensing or fitting hearing alds.

7 (d)(3) one One alternate member shall be appointed 8 from for each of the three lists -- to regular member. Each 9 alternate member must be appointed in the same manner and 10 must possess the same minimum qualifications as the 11 corresponding regular member and shall serve when a the 12 regular member cannot attend a scheduled meeting. 13 (d)(4) Each member shall serve for a term of 3 years.

14 A member may not be reappointed within 1 year after the 15 expiration of his second consecutive full term. If a vacancy 16 occurs on the board, the governor shall appoint a person 17 from-the-some-list in the same manner and with the same 18 minimum qualifications as the member whose term was not 19 completed.

20 (4)(5) The board is allocated to the department for
 21 administrative purposes only as prescribed in 2-15-121.\*\*

22 Section 2. Transition. This act does not affect the 23 term of office of any person who is a board member on July 24 1, 1979, and any such person may serve out the remainder of 25 his unexpired term.
