NEW SECTION. Section 2. Reallocation fees collected for alcoholism services. All fees collected from persons receiving services from the Galen alcoholism program shall be deposited and retained in a special account within department of administration. The department of administration shall:

- (1) beginning with the second quarter of the fiscal year and every quarter thereafter, return fees collected and deposited to the residing county of the person receiving services. These funds shall be used for the treatment. rehabilitation, and prevention of alcoholism as approved by the state.
- (2) when fees are collected and deposited for services for alcoholism or complications thereof from persons residing outside the state, the fees shall be returned to the department of institutions each quarter. Quarterly payments received by the department of institutions shall be used for the treatment, rehabilitation, and prevention of alcoholism.
