18 19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Prohibition of state mandates of items subject to collective bargaining. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any item within the scope of collective bargaining, including but not limited to minimum wayes in excess of federal standards, working conditions, and fringe benefits, may not be mandated by the legislature or any political subdivision of the state of Montana.

(2) The provisions of subsection (1) do not apply when the legislature appropriates the necessary funds to pay the costs of the mandated item.
