4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE
 5 LEGISLATURE FROM MANDATING ANY ITEM WITHIN THE SCOPE OF
 6 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UNLESS THE LEGISLATURE APPROPRIATES
 7 THE NECESSARY FUNDS TO PAY THE COSTS OF THE MANDATED ITEM."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Prohibition of state mandates of items
 11 subject to collective bargaining. (1) Notwithstanding any
 12 other provision of law, any item within the scope of
 13 collective bargaining, including but not limited to minimum
 14 wages in excess of federal standards, working conditions,
 15 and fringe benefits, may not be mandated by the legislature
 16 or any political subdivision of the state of Montana.

17 (2) The provisions of subsection (1) do not apply when
 18 the legislature appropriates the necessary funds to pay the
 19 costs of the mandated item.
