A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A PRORATED TAX ON MOBILE HOMES LEAVING THE STATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Prorated taxes upon mobile homes leaving the state. If a mobile home, as defined in 15-24-201, is moved from a point within the state to another point out of the state before the assessment date, the county treasurer shall prorate the tax due in the same proportion that the number of months the property has its taxable situs in the county bears to the total number of months in the taxable year.

This bill provides for a prorated tax on mobile homes leaving the state.
