A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PERMIT NONRESIDENT BOATERS 90 DAYS' RECIPROCITY; AMENDING SECTION 23-2-514, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 23-2-514, MCA, is amended to read:

"23-2-514. Exemption from numbering provisions. A motorboat shall not be required to be numbered under this part if it is:

(1) already covered by a number in full force and effect which has been awarded to it pursuant to federal law or a federally approved numbering system of another state, provided that such vessel shall not have been within this state for a period in excess of 60 20 consecutive days. After 60 20 consecutive days within this state, this state becomes the motorboat's state of principal use and the owner must apply for a Montana number, certificate of number, and license decal.

(2) a motorboat from a country other than the United States temporarily using the waters of this state;

(3) a motorboat whose owner is the United States, a state or subdivision thereof;

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(4) a ship's lifeboat."
