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4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A MEDICAL S REVIEW BOARD TO INVESTIGATE AND MAINTAIN QUALITY CONTROL OF MEDICAL PRACTICE IN THE STATE PRISON, AND TO ESTABLISH

7 RULEMAKING AUTHORITY."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Definitions. In [this act] unless the context requires otherwise, the following definitions apply:

- (1) "Department" means the department of health and environmental sciences provided for in Title 2, chapter 15, part 21.
- 15 (2) "Board" means the board of institutional medical
 16 review created by [section 2].
 - (3) "Medical practice" means medical, dental, nursing, psychiatric, and pharmaceutical practice.
 - Section 2. Establishment, composition, and duties of institutional medical review board. (1) A medical review board for the state prison is established for the purpose of investigating and maintaining quality control of medical, dental, nursing, psychiatric, nutritional, and pharmaceutical practice.
 - (2) The board consists of eight members appointed by

1 the governor from a list of persons recommended by a group

- of professional peers from the following professions:
- 3 (a) medicine;
- 4 (b) dentistry;
- (c) nursing;
- (d) psychiatry;
- 7 (e) psychology;
- 8 (f) pharmacy;
- (g) criminology.
- 10 (3) There shall be two pharmacists on the board; one 11 of whom is knowledgeable of "street drugs".
- 12 (4) The board shall report its findings after each 13 investigation to the governor, to each legislator, and the 14 attorney general.
- 15 Section 3. Accountability and rulemaking authority.
- 16 (1) The board is responsible to the board of health and 17 environmental sciences.
- 18 (2) The board of health and environmental sciences
 19 shall adopt rules pertaining to:
- 20 (a) procedures for investigating and maintaining the 21 quality control of medical practice, including but not 22 limited to dispensing drugs to inmates of the state prison;
- 23 (b) compliance measures adopted by the board of 24 institutional medical review;
- 25 (c) procedures relating to professional peer

1 recommendation and member selection to the board of 2 institutional medical review;

3 . (d) any other procedures that may be necessary for the4 administration of [section 2].

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Section 4. Compensation. Each member of the board shall receive expenses for traveling to and from board meetings and for each full day away from home while conducting board business as provided for in 2-18-501 through 2-18-503.
