5 RELATING TO TEACHER TENURE UNDER EDUCATIONAL COOPERATIVE
6 AGREEMENT CONTRACTS ENTERED INTO BY SCHOOL DISTRICTS OR
7 OTHER PUBLIC AGENCIES."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
10 Section 1. Tenure under educational cooperative
11 agreements. (1) Teachers who have tenure rights with a
12 district that participates in a cooperative agreement under
13 the provisions of Title 7, chapter 11, part 1, and Title 20,
14 chapter 9, part 7, do not lose their tenure rights with the
15 district when employed by the cooperative agreement in a
16 position that requires teacher certification.
17 (2) Nontenure teachers employed under the provisions
18 of Title 7, chapter 11, part 1, and Title 20, chapter 9,
19 part 7, acquire tenure with the prime agency, as defined in
20 20-9-701, in the same manner as prescribed in 20-4-203, and
21 the provisions of 20-4-204 through 20-4-207 are applicable
22 to such teachers.
23 (3) For the purposes of tenure of a teacher employed
24 under the provisions of Title 7, chapter 11, part 1, and
25 Title 20, chapter 9, part 7, educational cooperative

1 agreement contract renewals may not be used to limit the
2 teacher's progress toward tenure status.

HOUSE BILL NO. 446
INTRODUCED BY DUSSAULT, SOUTH

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CLARIFY PROVISIONS
RELATING TO TEACHER TENURE UNDER ~~EDUCATIONAL-COOPERATIVE~~
REGIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT CONTRACTS ENTERED INTO BY SCHOOL
DISTRICTS OR OTHER PUBLIC AGENCIES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Tenure under ~~educational-cooperative~~
REGIONAL SERVICES agreements. (1) Teachers who have tenure
rights with a district that participates in a ~~cooperative~~
REGIONAL SERVICES agreement under the provisions of
~~20-7-415~~, Title 7, chapter 11, part 1, and Title 20, chapter
9, part 7, do not lose their tenure rights with the district
when employed by the ~~cooperative~~ REGIONAL SERVICES agreement
in a position that requires teacher certification.

(2) Nontenure teachers employed under the provisions
of ~~20-7-415~~, Title 7, chapter 11, part 1, and Title 20,
chapter 9, part 7, acquire tenure with the ~~prime-agency~~
~~defined-in-20-9-701~~, REGIONAL SERVICES ORGANIZATION in the
same manner as prescribed in 20-4-203, and the provisions of
20-4-204 through 20-4-207 are applicable to such teachers.

(3) For the purposes of tenure of a teacher employed
under the provisions of ~~20-7-415~~, Title 7, chapter 11, part

1, and Title 20, chapter 9, part 7, ~~educational-cooperative~~
REGIONAL SERVICES agreement contract renewals may not be
used to limit the teacher's progress toward tenure status.
