(4) "Electrology" means the study and professional practice of removing superfluous hair by destroying the hair roots with--an-electrified-needle by passage of an electric current by any method APPROVED BY THE BOARD. Electrology as defined in this chapter shall include electrolysis and/or thermolysis."
