BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Out-of-state contributions limited. A candidate or a political committee organized to support or oppose a candidate or a ballot issue may not accept contributions in excess of 10% of the total amount spent by the candidate or political committee or \$50,000, whichever is the greater sum, from persons who are not residents of the state of Montana.

Section 2. Codification. Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 13, chapter 37, and the provisions contained in Title 13, chapter 37, apply to section 1.
