 5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF
 6 FUNDS CONTRIBUTED TO POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS BY OUT-OF-STATE
 7 CONTRIBUTORS."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 9 Section 1. Out-of-state contributions limited. A
 10 candidate or a political committee organized to support or
 11 oppose a candidate or a ballot issue may not accept
 12 contributions in excess of 10% of the total amount spent by
 13 the candidate or political committee or \$50,000, whichever
 14 is the greater sum, from persons who are not residents of
 15 the state of Montana.
 16 Section 2. Codification. Section 1 is intended to be
 17 codified as an integral part of Title 13, chapter 37, and
 18 the provisions contained in Title 13, chapter 37, apply to
 19 section 1.
