#### DESCRIPTION

This proposed bill requires the Department of Revenue to include in its report of property tax data for the state a breakdown of such data by county and city.

#### ASSUMPTIONS

The Biennial Report of the Department has always given a county by county analysis of the tax base. Therefore, the costs incurred are connected with the addition of city data.

- 1. In counties where all records are computerized, new programs will have to be written in order to compile the information in the form needed.
- 2. In counties where no records are computerized, the compilation will represent an added task the cost of which can be absorbed.
- 3. In counties which are partially computerized, additional computerization will be required in order to provide the compilation required.
  - 4. No change in Report format, except adding the data from 120 + cities and towns, will be attempted. It is estimated that adding sixty pages to the Report will increase the cost of printing by \$5,000.

    The cost of 1) through 3) is estimated to be \$80,000 each fiscal year statewide.
