A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE PUBLIC CAMPAIGN FUND AND TRANSFERRING ANY REMAINING FUNDS TO THE STATE GENERAL FUND; REPEALING SECTIONS 13-37-301 THROUGH 13-37-306, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
Section 1. Public campaign fund abolished. The public campaign fund is abolished. All remaining funds in the earmarked public campaign fund are transferred to the general fund.  
Section 2. Repealer. Sections 13-37-301 through 13-37-306, MCA, are repealed.

## FISCAL NOTE

In compliance with a written request received February 8, 19 79, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 484 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION

This proposed bill abolishes the Public Campaign Fund and transfers any remaining funds to the State General Fund.

ASSUMPTIONS

- a) It is assumed that the Public Campaign Fund balance as of June 30, 1979 will be \$220,000.
- b) The Department of Revenue forecast of individual income tax collections, and public campaign fund designations by taxpayers, for the 80-81 biennium are assumed to be correct.
