The ANB calculated for grades 7 and 8 shall be funded at the high school ANB rate provided that the school meets the standards for accreditation of a middle school. When such pupils are actually enrolled in an elementary school, the amount of the general fund budget per ANB shall be the same os that of the high-school-district within—which the elementary—school—is located is determined from the high school schedule using the total ANB of the elementary school. To determine the total enrollment ANB of such an elementary school for ANB purposes, the 7th and 8th grade pupils shall be included in such total."

In compliance with a written request received March 3, 1979, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 485 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 485 changes the funding for 7th and 8th grade students under the Foundation program to the amount given to high school students in high schools with an ANR equal to the elementary school in which the 7th and 8th grades are found. Under the old law, such ANB received the high school ANB rate equal to the high school in the elementary district in which the 7th and 8th grades are found.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The present Foundation program will continue.
- 2. Schools presently approved were used and there will be no changes in the 1981 Biennium.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Foundation Program of schools with 7th and 8th grade funding.
