A person applying for membership may also apply creditable service in the retirement system for out-of-state employment service that would have been acceptable under the provisions of this chapter if such service had been performed in the state of Montana. The person shall be awarded creditable service, conditional upon his completing 5 years of active membership in Montana, for the number of years, not exceeding 5, that the retirement board determines to be creditable service, if he contributes to the retirement system an amount equal to the combined employer and employee contribution for his first full year's teaching salary earned in Montana after his out-of-state service for each year of creditable service plus interest at the rate the contribution would have earned had the contribution been in his account upon the completion of 5

In compliance with a written request received March 2, 1979, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 491 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 491 provides for a change in the cost to a teacher to purchase credit for out-of-state teaching service from an amount equal to the employee contribution for his first full year's teaching salary earned in Montana following the out-of-state teaching service for each year purchased, plus interest, to an amount equal to the combined employee-employer contribution.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A dollar amount cannot be determined since we do not know how many teachers will purchase credit for out-of-state teaching service. House Bill 491 will provide the amount required to actuarially fund the additional service.
