A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION TO PERFORM INVESTIGATIONS ON WATER STORAGE SITES IN THE SIG HOLE RIVER BASIN AND TO CONDUCT A WATER DEMAND STUDY IN THE BIG HOLE AND JEFFERSON BASINS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the general fund to the department of natural resources and conservation the sum of \$86,500 for the biennium ending June 30, 1981, for the purpose of performing general site, engineering, geotechnical, survey, archaeological, wildlife, feasibility, and demand studies of seven off-stream potential water storage sites and of potential water uses along the Big Hole and Jefferson rivers, as identified in the report of the department and submitted to the Legislature in January, 1979, entitled "Potential Off-Stream Reservoir Sites in the Big Hole River Basin".
