INTRODUCED BY HAND, DAY, KEYSER

4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO
5 THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION TO
6 PERFORM INVESTIGATIONS ON WATER STORAGE SITES IN THE BIG
7 HOLE RIVER BASIN AND TO CONDUCT A WATER DEMAND STUDY IN THE
8 BIG HOLE AND JEFFERSON BASINS.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from
12 the general fund to the department of natural resources and
13 conservation the sum of \$86,500 for the biennium ending June
14 30, 1981, for the purpose of performing general site,
15 engineering, geotechnical, surveys, archaeological, wildlife,
16 feasibility, and demand studies of seven off-stream
17 potential water storage sites and of potential water uses
18 along the Big Hole and Jefferson rivers, as identified in
19 the report of the department and submitted to the
20 Legislature in January, 1979, entitled "Potential Off-Stream
21 Reservoir Sites in the Big Hole River Basin".
