A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 61-5-111, MCA, TO PROVIDE A ONE-STOP LICENSING PROCEDURE FOR THE ISSUANCE AND PAYMENT OF FEES FOR DRIVERS* LICENSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-5-111, MCA, is amended to read: "61-5-111. Licenses issued to operators and chauffeurs -- renewals and expiration thereof -- fees. (1) The division shall have authority to appoint county treasurers and other qualified officers to act as its agents for the sale of drivers* licenses receipts, and shall make necessary rules governing such sales. In those areas where the division provides driver licensing services 3 days or more a week the division is responsible for sale of receipts and may not appoint an agent. The division, upon payment of the fees specified in this section, tof-which see -5% -shall be retained-by-the-county-tressurers-for-use-of-the-county qeneral-fund; shall issue to every applicant qualifying therefor an operator's or chauffeur's license as applied for. Such licenses shall contain a photograph of such licensee in such size and form as may be prescribed by the division, a distinguishing number issued to the licensee,

the full name, date of birth, resident address, and a brief description of the licensee, and either a facsimile of the signature of the licensee or a space upon which he shall write his signature in pen and ink immediately upon receipt of the license. No license shall be valid until it has been so signed by the licensee. Five percent of the license fees collected by the county treasurer shall be deposited by the county treasurer shall be deposited by the county treasurer for the use of the county general fundative percent of the license fees collected by the division shall be retained by the division to defray the cost of handlings.
