4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW

5 CONCERNING THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO MAKE

6 THE ASSUMPTION BY A CONTRACTING EMPLOYER OF THE MEMBERS'

7 CONTRIBUTIONS A SUBJECT OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING; PROVIDING

8 A PROCEDURE FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH CONTRIBUTIONS BY THE

9 EMPLOYER; AND AMENDING SECTION 19-3-701, MCA."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Section 19-3-701, MCA, is amended to read:

13 "19-3-701. Member's contribution to be deducted. III

14 The normal contribution of each member shall be equal to 6%

15 of his compensation. The Except as provided in subsection

16 121, the chief administrative officer of each employer shall

17 deduct the contribution from the compensation of each member

18 and remit the total of the contributions to the board.

19 Payment of salaries or wages less the contribution shall be

20 full and complete discharge and acquittance of all claims

21 and demands whatsoever for the service rendered by members

22 during the period covered by the payment, except their

23 claims to the benefits to which they may be entitled under

24 the provisions of this chapter.

25 (2) The normal contributions of members who are

1 employed by a contracting employer may be a subject of
2 collective bargaining negotiations between the contracting
3 employer and an exclusive representative of the members
4 pursuant to Title 39, chapter 31. If a contracting employer
5 executes a collective bargaining agreement that requires it
6 to pay all or a portion of the members' contributions, it
7 shall make such payments as provided in 19-3-804 and such
8 payments shall be in addition to the employer contribution
9 required under 19-3-801."
