EMPLOYER: AND AMENDING SECTION 19-3-701, MCA.\*

Section 1. Section 19-3-701, MCA. is amended to read:

#19-3-701. Member's contribution to be deducted. 111

The normal contribution of each member shall be equal to 6% of his compensation. The Except as provided in subsection 121: the chief administrative officer of each employer shall deduct the contribution from the compensation of each member and remit the total of the contributions to the board. Payment of salaries or wages less the contribution shall be full and complete discharge and acquittance of all claims and demands whatsoever for the service rendered by members during the period covered by the payment, except their claims to the benefits to which they may be entitled under the provisions of this chapter.

(2) The normal contributions of members who are

employed by a contracting employer may be a subject of

collective bargaining negotiations between the contracting

employer and an exclusive representative of the members

pursuant to litle 39, chapter 31. If a contracting employer

executes a collective bargaining agreement that requires it

to pay all or a portion of the members' contributions; it

shall make such payments as provided in 19-3-804 and such

payments shall be in addition to the employer contribution

required under 19-3-801.\*
