Section 1. Limitations on contributions to influence the outcome of a statewide ballot issue. (1) A person may not contribute an aggregate amount in excess of \$500 to influence the outcome of an election on a statewide ballot issue.

(2) An independent political committee may not contribute an aggregate amount in excess of \$1,000 to influence the outcome of a statewide ballot issue. For the purposes of this section, an independent political campaign committee means a committee which is not organized to support or oppose a ballot issue or which is not controlled directly or indirectly by a committee to support or oppose a ballot issue in conjunction with the making of expenditures or accepting contributions.

Section 2. Codification. Section 1 is intended to be codified in Title 13. chapter 27. part 2. and the provisions contained in Title 13. chapter 27. part 2. apply to section
