8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
9 Section 1. Immunity in case of water projects. The  
10 state or any political subdivision thereof is immune from  
11 suit for injury to persons or property for damages arising  
12 from the operation, maintenance, repair, or failure of a  
13 state-owned water project, as defined in 85-1-102.



Description of Proposed Legislation:

House Bill 530 is an act granting the State immunity from suit for injury to persons or property arising from state-owned water projects.
