In compliance with a written request received <u>February 5</u>, 19, 79, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>HB 533</u> pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF LEGISLATION:

House Bill 533 requires the state to use private air transportation when such transportation can be provided at a cost lower than state air transportation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Section 2-2.4 (1) - S4130, Administrative Rules of Montana currently requires that state employees travel by the least expensive class of service available within the mode of transportation being utilized. Consequently, this legislation should have minimal fiscal impact on state agency travel costs. Studies by the Legislative Auditor, however, have shown that in some cases the cost of private air transportation can be significantly less than comparable state air transportation when factors other than direct cost are considered.
