12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-4-2505, MCA, is amended to read: \*7-4-2505. Amount of compensation for deputies and assistants. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), the boards of county commissioners in the several counties in the state shall have the power to fix the compensation allowed any deputy or assistant of the following officers:
