In compliance with a written request received February 5, 1979, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 551 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 551 is legislation proposed to increase compensation of Fish and Game license agents from 15 cents to 30 cents for each license, permit, or certificate issued.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

1. It is assumed license year 1980 will incur \$148,000 in license agent costs.
2. It is assumed license year 1981 will incur \$150,000 in license agent costs.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

License dealer fees under proposed law	\$296,000	\$300,000
License dealer fees under current law	<u>148,000</u>	<u>150,000</u>
Increased dealer fees under proposed law	<u>\$148,000</u>	<u>\$150,000</u>

The increased fees represent revenue lost to the Fish and Game Earmarked Revenue account.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 87-2-903, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "87-2-903. Compensation and duties of agents. (1)

13 License agents, except salaried employees of the department,

14 shall--receive are entitled to receive upon request for all

15 services rendered the sum of ~~5~~ 30 cents for each license,

16 permit, or certificate issued. On or before the 10th day of

17 each month each license agent shall submit to the department

18 all duplicates of each class of licenses sold during the

19 preceding month and shall accompany the duplicate licenses

20 with all moneys received for the sale of the licenses, less

21 a fee of ~~5~~ 30 cents for each license sold if the agent has

22 requested compensation. Each license agent shall keep his

23 license account open at all reasonable hours to inspection

24 by the department, the director, the wardens, or the

25 legislative auditor.
