A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$145,200 TO MAKOSHIKA STATE PARK LOCATED SOUTH OF GLENDIVE FOR EMERGENCY ROAD REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated \$145,200 from the coal tax state parks earmarked revenue account and the state parks federal and private revenue account to the Department of Fish and Game for emergency road repair and maintenance in Makoshika State Park, located south of Glendive. The money shall be appropriated from the designated accounts as follows:

State Parks Federal and Private	
Revenue Account	\$72,600
Coal Tax State Parks Earmarked	
Revenue Account	\$72,600

Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on passage and approval.



DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:
