9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Names of recipients of  
 11 general relief and aid to dependent children available for  
 12 inspection — limitations. The list of names of all persons  
 13 who have received general relief and aid to dependent  
 14 children assistance is a matter of public record. It is  
 15 available for inspection, subject to the limitations  
 16 specified in 53-2-105, at the local offices in the counties  
 17 where the recipients of the payments reside.

18 Section 2. Section 53-2-105, MCA, is amended to read:

19 "53-2-105. Misuse of public assistance information  
 20 unlawful. It shall be unlawful for any person, body,  
 21 association, firm, corporation, or other agency to solicit,  
 22 disclose, receive, make use of, or to authorize, knowingly  
 23 permit, participate in, or acquiesce in the use of any lists  
 24 or names for commercial or political purposes of any nature
